

Church Finances and Your Pledges

Today I would like to share the current financial status of our church and kindly encourage you to catch up with your pledges.

I am glad to share that our finances this year have been better than last year. It is mainly because of your continued contributions as well as of our ongoing efforts to reduce expenses. For example, thanks to the good relationship with Fleming Brother Landscaping, we have reduced our costs on ground maintenance tremendously. Since we saved the on cost of landscaping, we were able to take care of trees and make repairs to the roof. When the heating system upgrade project, which is currently undergoing, is completed, we expect a reduction in our utility bill as well. As for the connectional responsibility, we have already paid about fifty percent of our shared ministry. We aim to make at least seventyfive percent payment at the end of the year. I appreciate each and everyone who has made a donation to the church. I also thank our church leaders who work so faithfully to be a good steward of the gifts that God has given to us.

With this delightful report, I'd like to carefully bring your attention that it is time to catch up on what you have pledged to give. Usually, giving goes up as the people come back from summer vacation. It has been a month since the summer ends, but our finance team hasn't seen an increase in our giving yet. It concerns me because if we do not have a solid ground of church operation, it is difficult for us to help the people who are in need. Just as we cannot help others if our body is not strong enough, our church cannot help others if we do not stand as a healthy congregation in our essential operation. It is your regular and pledged donations on Sunday morning that enables us to send the extra help, for example, to the people in the Bahamas or the city of Paterson. So, if you haven't given what you pledged, please have a chance to catch up. In case you do not know how much you have given so far, please contact Linda Farber, our Finance Secretary, and she will kindly provide you the necessary information.

Once again, I appreciate your warm consideration in advance, and I thank God because you are a good steward of God's gifts. God Bless! —Pastor Myung
